- ❖ *A written notice of resignation with intent to retire shall be delivered to the Superintendent 150 days prior to the date of retirement.*
- ❖ *You must give this notice in order to receive the \$20 per day of accrued sick leave days.*
- ❖ ***If you plan to retire June 30th, this date is: FEBRUARY 1, 2016.***
